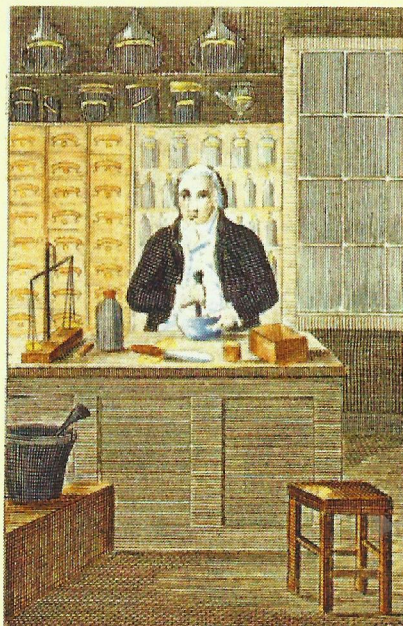

## WHO ARE WE?

The **British Society for the History of Pharmacy** was formed in 1967 having originated from a committee of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society. It seeks to act as a focus for the development of all areas of the history of pharmacy, from the works of the ancient apothecary to the ever-changing role

We welcome anyone with an interest in pharmacy history, including overseas members and institutions such as libraries. It is not necessary to be a pharmacist or a professional historian, and our members come from a broad range of backgrounds.



The yearly fee of £30 includes four issues of the *Pharmaceutical Historian*, affiliation to the International Society for the History of Pharmacy and the British Society for the History of Medicine, the opportunity to attend regular meetings with guest speakers, join visits to places of historic interest and attend, or take part in, the Annual Conference.

We are keen to support pharmacy history research at all levels. Members have free access to the Royal Pharmaceutical Society Library for reference and private study (prior appointment required). We also provide guidance on our website, work with other organisations to run pharmacy history events, and offer annual bursaries to fund research projects.

Assistance is available, if required, with historical research or even tracing the origins and function of that 'mysterious' artefact.
