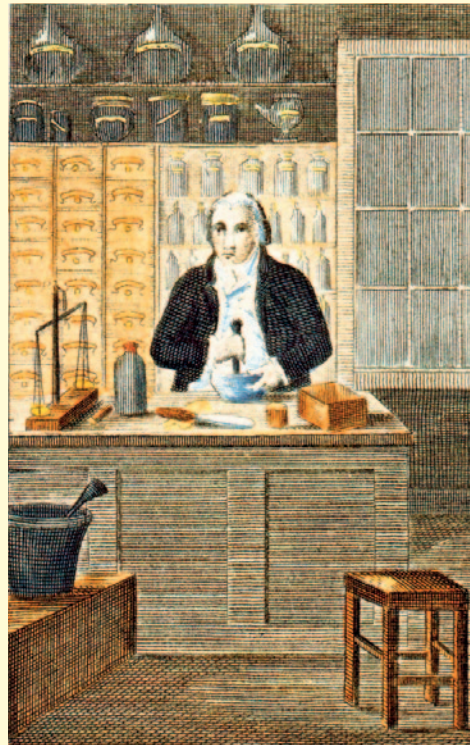

## WHO ARE WE?

The **British Society for the History of Pharmacy** was formed in 1967 having originated from a committee of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society. It seeks to act as a focus for the development of all areas of the history of pharmacy, from the works of the ancient apothecary to the ever-changing role of today's pharmacist in health provision.

What does membership involve? A few facts may answer some of the more obvious questions. The only qualification required is an interest in the history of pharmacy. It is not necessary to be a pharmacist or a professional historian.



The yearly fee of £20 includes four issues of the *Pharmaceutical Historian*, affiliation to the International Society for the History of Pharmacy and the British Society for the History of Medicine, the opportunity to attend regular meetings with guest speakers, join visits to places of historic interest and attend, or take part in, the Annual Conference.

There are no demands on members, but those wishing to undertake research will find helpful links on our web page to the RPS Library and Museum. Members have free access to the RPS Library.

Assistance is available, if required, with historical research or even tracing the origins and function of that 'mysterious' artefact.
